

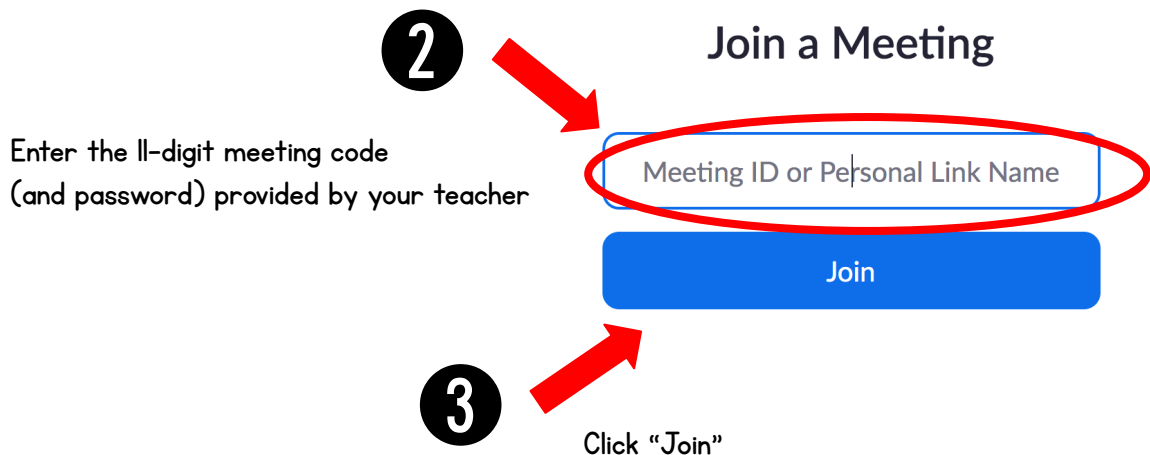
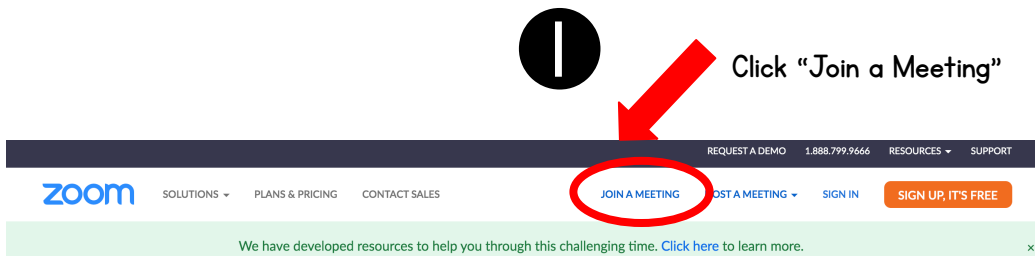

your teacher will admit you to the Zoom!**







How do I change my name?

If you are logging into Zoom for the first time:

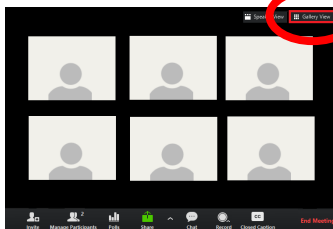
please make sure to type THE STUDENT'S name when prompted.

If you have logged into Zoom in the past:

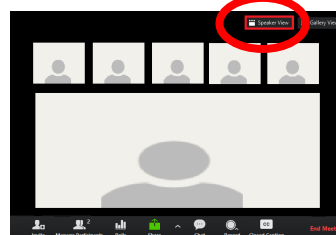
1. Click on  at the bottom of the screen.

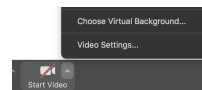

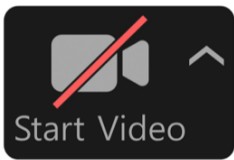
How do I change to a Virtual Background

3. Choose your background 

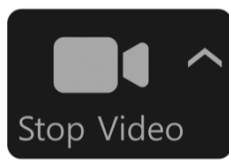




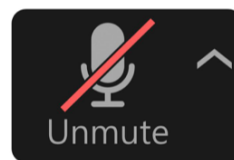

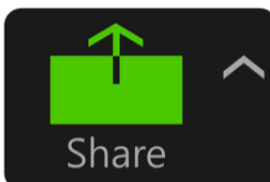
Student can show their teacher a reaction that will appear in their photo tile



Raise Hand

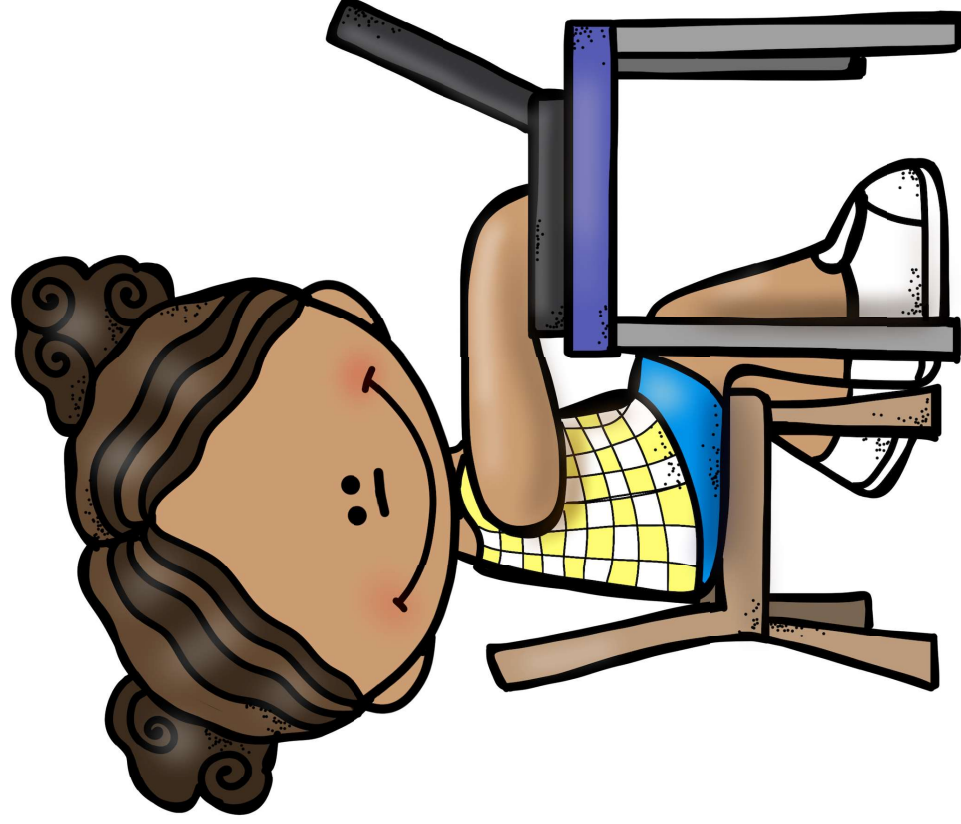


Click on the Participants icon and then click Raise Hand on the bottom of the popup window to signal to the teacher

Before you Zoom Checklist

- ☐ Is your device charged?
- ☐ Are you in a quiet place with no distractions?
- ☐ Are you at a work space like a desk or table?
- ☐ Are you dressed for success?

While you Zoom

- Use gallery view
- Pay attention to the speaker
- Mute your microphone if you are not talking
- When you are talking look into the camera and speak loudly and clearly.
- Only one student should talk at a time. Use the chat feature to ask questions or raise your hand. Wait for your teacher to call on you.
